Meeting to contract with East Lawn Investment Co. to buy approximately 15 acres to operate as a cemetery. Rules & Regulations adopted.

## November 9, 1925


Welch Holding Company of California is incorporated in the State of California.


East Lawn Investment Co. opens the first cremetory in Sacramento, Located next to the original well and garage, it was in the area where Palm Court is today.








## Palm Court

Many prefer this out of door entombment as evidenced by the fact that over 500 crypts are contained in this unit alone. A further unit has been planned and will be erected as soon as conditions will permit. Crypts in this unit are now as low as \$200.00.
